Elisha Duncan, of Longmont, father of Robert Duncan and police magistrate Duncan, of Boulder, died last Monday morning at his residence in the former place, aged 71 years. He came to Colorado in 1858, and was the promoter and one of the owners of the first toll-roads in this state. He had always been a stock-raiser and engaged in mining. A widow survives him as also four sons and two daughters.
