

Notice to Non-Residents.

Be it known, that on the 18th
day of November, 1931, the
above named plaintiff, by his at-
torney, filed in the office of the
clerk of the Tipton Circuit Court
of Tipton county, State of Indi-
ana, his complaint against all the
defendants to the above entitled
cause, and also the affidavit of a
competent person, showing that
the defendants, Anna VanBriggle,
— VanBriggle, the unknown
widow of Henry VanBriggle, de-
ceased, the unknown husbands
and wives, widows and widowers,
heirs at law, devisees, legatees,
mortgagees, trustees, receivers,
grantees, lessees, executors, ad-
ministrators, representatives, suc-
cessors and assigns of each and
all the defendants hereto whose
names are as follows, to-wit:
Henry VanBriggle, deceased; An-
na VanBriggle, deceased; and
— VanBriggle, deceased, and
unknown widow of Henry Van-
Briggle, deceased, are all non-
residents of the State of Indiana,
that their places of residence and
their addresses are each and all
unknown, and cannot be ascer-
tained and that plaintiff has
made due, legal and diligent ef-
fort and inquiry to ascertain the
same, and that all of them are
necessary parties to this suit; that
said complaint is to quiet the ti-
tle to and to sell the real estate
of said decedent, Henry VanBrig-
gle, to settle and administer his
estate, which real estate is si-
tuated in Tipton County, Indiana,
and is described as follows, to-
wit: Lot numbered 11 in the
Town of Harmony, sub-division of
the southwest quarter of the
southeast quarter of section 8,
township 21 north, range 6 east,
against all the defendants to this
action and against all claims,
claimants and demands; and
whereas, said plaintiff having by
indorsement on said complaint
required all of said defendants
to appear in said court and an-
swer or demur thereto on the
22nd day of January, 1932,
