## CHARGED WITH STEALING 4 AUTOS

Guy B. Duncan on Trial in District  
Court on First Case Today

Guy B. Duncan is on trial in the District court at Boulder on the charge of stealing an auto from Daniel Huck of Denver. He is said to have used the machine in the rent business from Boulder to Nederland last summer. Three other charges will probably be placed against Duncan of stealing cars of Mr. Bowen of Longmont, Chas. Bohn of Longmont and E. C. Randall of Boulder. The latter two machines were recovered after they had been stripped of tires and other removable parts. Duncan plead not guilty at a hearing on Nov. 24, 1915 and his trial has been postponed on various motions until now.
