

SIT DOWN, MR DUNCAN.

Judge Palmer at Denver is Very Uncivil to our Guy D.

Guy D. Duncan, a lawyer from Boulder, was put out of Judge Palmer's court room yesterday by Bailiff Dowson on order of the judge. Duncan declined to sit down when ordered by Judge Palmer to do so, says the Denver Republican.

The attorney said that he had a petition for the release from the county jail of George W. Cole, former conservator of the estate of "Buckskin Jimmy" White. Judge Palmer ordered his clerk to place the matter on the notice docket.

"It will come up in its regular order" said the judge.

This did not satisfy Duncan who wanted a definite date set for hearing. Accordingly Duncan continued to talk.

"Sit down," said Judge Palmer. "I have made the order in the case and I intend the order to stand."

But Duncan persisted in remaining on his feet. Thereupon the court told the bailiff to remove Duncan from the room; and as he was being taken away Judge Palmer added, "You may consider yourself fortunate, sir, that I have not remanded you to the county jail."

The petition of Cole states that he was sent to the county jail on July 25 of last year for failing to pay into court \$2,303 of "Buckskin Jimmy's" estate, on what he terms "the pretended judgment." Cole says he is insolvent and therefore can not pay the judgment. He says that he gets only \$12 a month, a pension, and which he says he has to spend for medicines and food to supplement what is furnished him by the authorities of the county jail.

[The treatment of Mr Duncan is about what an outside attorney can expect of the fellows who happen to be vested with a little brief authority on the bench of Denver. Citizens of Boulder county know Mr Duncan to be a well behaved, polite and reasonably honest attorney. They will, therefore, think none the less of him because a dyspeptic judge shows his authority. Mr Duncan, who has returned from Denver, laughs but says nothing. It leaks out that he afterwards met the judge in the latter's chambers and his reception was most cordial.— Editor Camera.]
