Age 96, of Upper St. Clair, was called to heaven to be with his beloved wife, Jane on Thursday, January 10, 2019. Cliff was a longtime resident of Friendship Village, leaving many friends there. He was married to Jane for 65 years, having three sons: David W. (Barbara), Richard C. (Linda), and Thomas S.
